

## UNIFORM POLICY

Parents and students have primary responsibility for personal appearance. However, the principal is responsible for interpretation and maintenance of the uniform policy. Students who are not in uniform will call home and will be given a dress code referral. Three or more dress code referrals per month will result in an after school detention.

- **Shirt / Blouse:** Button-up collar and long enough to be tucked-in.  
Cotton or cotton/poly; long or short sleeves  
Solid color with **no logo**, except St. Francis School logo  
**Colors: light blue, light yellow, white**
- **Polo Shirt:** Button style with collar and long enough to tuck in  
Cotton or cotton/poly; long or short sleeves  
Solid color with **no logo**, except St. Francis School logo  
**Colors: red, dark green, navy blue, light blue  
light yellow, or white**
- **Turtleneck:** Long sleeves only, same colors as the polo shirt  
Solid color with **no logo**, except St. Francis School logo
- **Sweater:** Cardigan or V-neck; sweater vest  
**Colors: red, dark green, or navy blue**
- **Sweatshirt:** Navy blue or gray sweatshirts with the school logo or  
Solid color crew neck: navy blue, dark green, red.
- **Jumper, skirt(pleated or A-line)  
or Skort** **Colors: Marymount plaid, solid navy blue  
or khaki twill.**  
**Marymount plaid can be purchased only from  
Dennis Uniform Company or St. Francis School**
- **Pants / Shorts:** Dockers style --- **NO CARGO** Pants or shorts  
**Colors: navy blue or khaki twill**  
Acceptable: elastic waistbands  
Prohibited: jeans-style pants with outside pockets;  
pedal pushers; clam diggers; bell bottom  
style pants; or cargo pants.
- **Belts** are required and must be visible, unless the waistband is elastic and has no belt loops.

- **Shoes:** Most styles are acceptable. For safety reasons, the following are prohibited:  
Flip-flops, slip-ons, sandals without straps, platform shoes, & boots.
- **Socks:** are to worn at all times and must be **VISIBLE** above the shoe line.  
**Colors: solid white, navy or light blue, red, green yellow.**
- **Headgear** (e.g. baseball cap, scarf, etc.) is prohibited during the school day, inside.
- **Jewelry:** Conservative; pierced earrings must be studded—No hoops or dangling earrings.
- **Makeup:** is allowed only in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grades. It must be subtle, including nail polish.  
No lip gloss or lipstick in K-6.
- **Cleanliness:** No tattoos—homemade or commercial
- **General:**
  - All clothing must fit **appropriately**: No baggy pants or shorts. Pant length stops at the ankle, not at the bottom of the shoe or touching the floor.
  - Hem-lines for all jumpers, skirts, skorts, and shorts must be no more than 3 inches above the kneecap.
  - All clothing must be in good repair (without holes, etc.)
  - All students are required to keep their shirts tucked in at all times.
  - Pants and shorts may be worn all year. Capris must be approved by the principal.
  - No long shirts under short sleeved shirts.
- Dennis Uniform is the only place that carries the Marymount plaid. All other items can be purchased at local stores, Land's End, (Back On The Rack) SAI, or through Dennis Uniform. Only the St. Francis School logo is allowed. Any other logo is not allowed and will be considered in violation of the uniform policy.
- The school does have used uniforms available in limited supply.
- **Free Dress Days will be on the last Thursday of each month as designated on the monthly calendar.**
- **Clothes excluded on free dress days:**
  - Clothes with holes or in disrepair
  - Athletic sweats or nylon P.E. shorts
  - Midriff blouses, tank tops or visible spaghetti straps
  - Bike shorts, leggings and spandex
  - Military and camouflage style
  - Clothing advertising rock bands, sex, drugs, alcohol, or symbols with inappropriate language
  - Long sleeve shirts under short sleeve shirts
  - Cargo style, baggy or dragging pant legs

K-2 students need to send an extra pair of clothes for emergency use.
